You will respond to the question “What is Happiness?” in one of the following ways:

1. Short Story (3-5 pages) must include all elements of a short story
2. 5 paragraph Essay - Must cite at least 3 sources in support of your thesis
3. Poetry Anthology - At least 5 different forms of poetry, and must include at least 5 different literary devices
4. TED Talk Speech (3-5 minutes; need to submit the written speech and video recording)
5. Art Form (any) - Must include a 500 word artist statement that discusses the colours, images, and symbolism used to show your depth of understanding of the question.
